MEETING

Assistant Chief McNeal discussed emergency calls during the recent snowstorms. He stated that until the hydrants become visible, they will run the tanker and ask for assistance during calls.

President Knotts discussed re-vamping the brush truck versus a new truck which potentially saves approximately \$80,000.

Mr. Karge discussed snow removal and response times for the Department. He complimented the members for their response and dedication.
