Present from Easton Fire Department were Chief Jamie McNeal, President Tim McNeal, Trustee Phil Marshall, Fire Department members Mr. Jason Spies and Mr. Rick Stacey.

MEETING

President Ford called the meeting to order at 6:15 p.m.

Chief McNeal discussed automatic fire alarms and the Department's intent to be more proactive.

Representatives from Axis recently visited the Fire Department and discussed Worker's Compensation.

President McNeal stated that fund drive request letters have been mailed.

The Trustees will submit specifications for a new truck at tonight's Fire Department.
