25 At 6:18 p.m., President Ford called the Police Board meeting to order.

29 Chief Spencer introduced new employees Patrolman Yuri Wallace, July 11 Police Academy Recruit
30 Daniel Downes and Police Academy Recruit Megan Patchett.

32 Chief Spencer discussed personnel changes at the Department.

34 Chief Spencer discussed the Maryland Law Enforcement Challenge and the Maryland's Annual Law
35 Enforcement Torch Run for Special Olympics.

37 Chief Spencer advised that they have completed their required 18 hours In-Service Training. He
38 stated that they opened it up to allied agencies.

40 On April 25, PNC Bank on Marlboro Road was robbed and within 48 hours had two subjects in
41 custody within 48 hours.

43 Mrs. Cook joined the meeting at 6:28 p.m.

45 Chief Spencer discussed upcoming events.

47 Capt. Waltrup distributed new Easton Police Department badges for council review.

49 Chief Spencer stated that the new replacement patrol cars have been ordered.

51 The Maryland State Police is the recipient of a grant which will be distributed to Easton Police
52 Department for a License Plate Reader (LPR) Program.

54 Chief Spencer discussed a \$3,000 grant received from Wal-Mart and the proposed use. He stated they
55 intend to host a speaker October 20 at Easton High School and open the seminar to other agencies.

57 Mayor Willey asked if the department is in favor of reinstating the school Resource Officer at the
58 High School. Chief Spencer stated that they are in favor but the School Board needs to realize that
59 the officer is an employee of the Easton Police Department.

61 Easton Police Department's morale and public perception in the community was discussed.

63 President Ford discussed noise complaints and early deliveries at Taco Bell.

65 President Ford discussed speeding complaints at the corner of Pennsylvania and August Street.

67 The safety and laws for motor scooters were discussed.
