Regular meeting of the Park Advisory Board was opened by Mr. Michael Weise.

Upon motioned by Mr. Jeff Parks, seconded by Mr. Michael Weise and carried unanimously, minutes of the January 26, 2015 meeting were approved as written.

Mrs. Gould reported recommendations from the Park Board were forwarded to the Mayor and Town Council. Further information was requested on why the RTC Park is deemed inappropriate location for the Dog Park and recommendations for a skate park.

Mr. Parks spoke on information from his joint meeting with Talbot County and Town of Easton Park Board meeting. No group has come to Talbot County requesting an area for a dog park. The sign that was on an area on Klondike Road has been removed. Upon motioned by Mr. Jeff Parks, seconded by Mr. Michael Weise and carried unanimously the Park Board voted to send a recommendation to Mayor and Town Council they did not want to commit to anything else in RTC Park until a second entrance is made and an overall master plan is established.

Upon motioned by Mr. Jeff Parks, second by Mr. Michael Brophy and carried unanimously the Park Board voted to send the recommendation to Mayor and Town Council to place a skate park area on the back parking lot in the sports complex. The Board is aware may lose a few parking spaces on that particular lot, but already adding spaces in the complex in other areas. The asphalt is already there, accessible from the Rail Trail and will be visible.

Thompson Park restoration project is to begin in March if weather is permitting. Contractors will coordinate with Mrs. Gould prior to work.

Public Works department is doing a good job replacing the fencing at the sports complex. Weather has not let them complete it as planned, but they are moving along.

No more business brought before this meeting.
