Regular meeting of Park Advisory Board opened by Mr. Michael Weise.

Upon motioned by Mr. Otis Sampson, seconded by Mr. Michael Weise and carried unanimously, minutes of the February 23, 2015 meeting were approved as written.

Mrs. Gould reported she sent a reminder to Mrs. Garcia requesting she send information on the dog park proposal that the Park Advisory Board requested. As of today nothing has been received and there has been no further response from her.

Park Board members advised Mrs. Gould to continue moving forward with plans to place the skate park at the sports complex. This would be the ideal place for it.

Talbot Lacrosse Association will pay for the 50' X 10' fence to be placed near the end of Acorn Field and the property on Chapel Road that back to the area at the sports complex. Mrs. Gould will be available with this process.

Renovation in Thompson Park will begin next week. The park will be closed to all traffic. Mrs. Gould has coordinated with Easton Police Department marking off parking spaces on the Washington Street side of the park and all entrances for foot traffic to the park.

Water will be turned on at the sports complex, Idlewild and Moton park restrooms next week. The weather should stay above freezing that the pipes will not freeze now.

Mrs. Gould stated there are plans to have “Femi” baseball camp at the sports complex again this year. It has been successful in the past and would like to see it continue. She is waiting to get dates from Mr. Femi in order to advertise.

Baseball area in Matthewstown Run Park will possibly get a new look. Coaches on the Baybreeze Travel Ball would like to turn some of the grass, move home plate and place bases on the field. They would like to practice on the field at times.

Announcements: 1) April 11th will be the Project clean stream cleanup. There will be a group of Girl Scouts cleaning up in Stoney Ridge Park. Town park and recreation staff will be responsible for removing the bags and debris out when they are finished for the day. 2) Opening Day for baseball at the sports complex is April 11th 3) Chic Fil A will have a walk/run on RailTrail on April 11th. It will start and end at Idlewild Park. They will follow guidelines from their 2014 event.

Park Board meetings will remain the fourth Monday at noon monthly. There will be no meeting in December. Meeting for the month of May will be “as needed” since the fourth Monday will be Memorial Day. Mr. Michael Weise will remain as chairperson and Mr. Jeff Parks will remain the representative from the Town of Easton Park Board to the Talbot County Park and Recreation Board.

No more business brought before this meeting.
