Regular Park Advisory Board meeting brought to order by Mr. Weise. Upon motion by Mr. Sampson, seconded by Mr. Parks and carried unanimously, minutes of the February 26, 2018 meeting was approved.

Items from Director of Parks and Recreation and the Park Board:

- 1) Mrs. Gould is still waiting to receive date and times from Mr. Femi for this year's baseball camp.
- 2) Mr. Brophy will be giving Mrs. Gould dates for a soccer camp to be held at the sports complex this summer.
- 3) The design for the basketball court in Moton Park was chosen. Mrs. Gould shared it with the Park Board.
- 4) Mrs. Gould discussed with the Park Board possibility of painting in the play area at Idlewild Park when it is shut down while the surface is being replaced.
- 5) Opening of the restrooms and water being restored in the parks has been scheduled. Weather permitting this will be done during the first week of April.
- 6) Opening day for Little League baseball is April 7, 2018. When the weather and field condition permit, Park and Recreation staff have been getting on the fields preparing the fields for the season.
- 7) Mayor Willey and Mrs. Gould stated they have not heard anything further from Mr. Fink concerning the indoor facility for baseball. The Town is not the holdup at this time.
- 8) Park and Recreation staff painting inside at the Railway Station office.

- 9) Mrs. Gould and Mr. Richie Wheatley (Rotary Club) will meet in Idlewild Park to discuss a project that the Rotary can do. Mrs. Gould will share the information Mrs. Katie Reedy (Assistant Town Engineer) forwarded last year to the Rotary Club pertaining to a drip on the ground around the outside of the pavilion. If Mr. Wheatley has any other suggestions for a Rotary project, Mrs. Gould will bring them to the next Park Board meeting.
 - 10) Mrs. Gould and Mr. Parks talked briefly about adding infield mix to the baseball areas in Idlewild Park possibly in the future.
 - 11) Mrs. Gould will touch base with the girl scouts parents on the request to place a butterfly looking forward to meeting with them at a time that is convenient.
 - 12) Beautification Day is May 1st. The garden clubs will be cleaning and maintaining their gardens throughout the Town.
 - 13) Discussion on cars driving to the pavilion in Moton Park. Board will to thinking of various ideas to stop cars from driving through the park. Placing a barrier and signs could be an option.
 - 14) Received a letter from Mrs. Boots Michalak (Talbot County Garden Club) who would like to have a new entrance to the memorial garden in Idlewild Park. Mrs. Gould will speak with Mrs. Michalak to get a better understanding of what they are asking.
- Mayor Willey spoke with the Park Board to update them on the new bridge and activities that will be going on in the future such as placing a traffic light at the Glenwood Avenue intersection.
