Regular Park Advisory Board meeting opened by Mr. Michael Weise.

Upon motioned by Mr. Jeff Parks, seconded by Mr. Michael Brophy and carried unanimously, minutes of the June 1, 2015 meeting were approved as written.

Mrs. Kathy Garcia presented more information to the Park Board for a potential dog park in the RTC Park. Mrs. Garcia gave Mrs. Gould copies of rules and swipe card information from different dog parks to share with members of the Park Board.

Park Board members voted to set a date with the Council for a work session if necessary on a master plan for the RTC Park and have the dog park as one of the components.

Upon motioned by Mr. Jeff Parks, seconded by Mr. Mike Weise and carried unanimously, the Park Advisory Board voted to proceed with the resolution to add lighting at North Easton Sports Complex. The Park Board voted to send a recommendation to the Mayor and Town Council to approve the request to light of Anthony and Easton Club Fields at the sports complex.

Mrs. Gould reported the ribbon cutting is today in Thompson Park at 1:00 pm for the renovation of the park and lots of positive feedback on the appearance of the park.

Mrs. Gould reported she has asked Public Works to remove a bench located at the end of Laurel Street in area of the Rail Trail and place it closer inside of the park. Also, the dog station near the bridge will be moved and placed closer to the Goldsborough Street entrance of the Rail Trail.

Mrs. Gould informed members of the Park Board that the Rail Trail is actually safe. She has seen the presence of Easton Police on the trail at various times.

The Skate Park is being relocated to the back parking area at North Easton Sports Complex. Public Works is doing the work. The fence is up and a single ramp will be placed there at this time.

Baseball camp at North Easton Sports Complex is going well. The camp will run Monday through Thursday, unless there is a rain out and the makeup day will be on Friday.

Park Board members discussed brainstorming solutions to cut down on the amount of cars that park at the pavilion in Moton Park. It is not safe to have continuous traffic riding through the park.

Next meeting scheduled for July 27, 2015 at noon.

No more business brought before this meeting.

Upon motion by Mr. Weise, seconded by Mr. Parks and carried unanimously, the meeting was closed at 1:10 pm.
