## **January 17, 2016**

**1.** Home Invasion/Robbery/Assault: On 01-16-16 Easton Police were summoned to the area of South Street at Aurora Street in reference to a reported Robbery. Upon arrival at the scene police were met by a male subject, who advised that he had his Cellular phone stolen while he was at a party at another residence on Talbot Lane. The theft of the cell phone occurred during an altercation that he got into with an alleged assailant according to that male subject. He said that after he was accosted by the subject he left the residence on Talbot Lane and he returned home on South Aurora Street. He said that the subject he had gotten into the altercation with later came to his residence and offered to give him back his cell phone for \$100.00. He said he paid the money and then he was accosted again by his alleged assailant. He said he grabbed a box cutter and cut the hand of the assailant to protect himself. The assailant fled back to Talbot Lane, according to the alleged victim. The assailant was identified as Norman Lorenzo Carter, 32, of High Street in Easton. The victim identified Carter, whenever officers responded to Talbot Lane and found Carter hiding in a bathroom at the residence, where the party and altercation had taken place earlier. Carter was taken into custody. Police took Carter, the alleged victim and a witness back to the Easton Police Department to investigate further. Carter was subsequently charged upon further investigation with Home Invasion, Robbery, Assault 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree, and Theft Under \$1,000.00. Carter was processed at the Easton Police Department and subsequently he was taken before a District Court Commissioner for an Initial Appearance Hearing. At that time he was remanded to the Talbot County Detention Center on a bond of \$75,000.00. He awaits trial in this matter.
