1. **Criminal Summons Served (Violation Peace Order):** On 08-14-15 Easton Police served a Criminal Summons on Curt Vladimir Mardesich, 36, of Superior Circle in Easton. Mardesich stands formally charged with one count of Failing To Comply with a Peace Order on 07-20-15. Mardesich reportedly had contact with the respondent in this case and also he allegedly made obscene gestures towards the respondent. He has been ordered to refrain from all such activity in the Peace Order. Mardesich signed for his copies of the charging document and his free on his signature pending trial in this matter.
2. **Criminal Summons Served (False Prescription):** On 08-14-15 Easton Police served a Criminal Summons on John Sherman Ross, 27, of Jowite Street in Easton. Ross stands charged with one count of Obtaining a Controlled Dangerous Substance at a Pharmacy by False Identification and one count of Obtaining a Controlled Dangerous Substance by Fraud. The charges are a result of an investigation entered into by the Easton Police on 06-29-15, wherein the Walgreens Pharmacy called police whenever they realized that Ross had secured a prescription belonging to a deceased family member for himself. The prescription was for a heavy narcotic medication. Police verified who Ross was and then applied for criminal charges against Ross at the District Court. The District Court issued the aforementioned Criminal Summons. Ross signed for his copies of the charging document and he is free on his signature pending trial in this matter.

3. **Arrest Warrant Served (Assault 2nd Degree)**: On 08-14-15 Easton Police served an Arrest Warrant on Timothy Charles Krausz, 65, of Hemmersly Street in Easton. Krausz stands formally charged with Assault 2nd Degree, Trespass on Private Property, Harassment, and Malicious Destruction of Property. The charges are a result of an ongoing dispute that Krausz has had with a neighbor. Krausz and the neighbor have had issues since 2013 according to the charging documents. In one incident Krausz allegedly damaged a newly installed Air Conditioning Unit. Since 2013 Krausz has reportedly been constantly harassing his neighbor about issues that he has with that neighbor. On 08-08-15 Krausz allegedly approached the neighbor in the neighbor's yard and assaulted the neighbor. The neighbor called police and the neighbor was referred to the District Court Commissioner. The neighbor filed for charges on 08-12-15 and the aforementioned Arrest Warrant was issued for Krausz's arrest. Krausz was processed on the warrant at the Easton Police Department and subsequently he was taken before a District Court Commissioner for an Initial Appearance Hearing. He was released at that time on his personal recognizance pending trial in this matter.
