1. **Theft from a vehicle:** On September 4, 2015 the Easton Police Department responded to 50 Jowite Street in reference to a theft from a vehicle. Officers learned that sometime between 6 PM on September 3, 2015 and 7:30 AM on September 4, 2015 an unknown person stole a purse out of a truck that was parked at the residence. The victim, Jacqueline Roberts, advised that the purse and contents were valued at approximately \$55.00. Upon the officer's arrival he met with an Easton Utilities Employee, Roland Roney. Roney advised that he was in the store when he was advised that a tall white male had just taken a saw from his Easton Utilities vehicle. Upon checking his vehicle, Roney was able to verify that a Husqvarna Model 670 Partner Street Cutting Saw was missing. The saw is valued at \$1,500.
