1. **Malicious Destruction of Property:** On September 15, 2015 the Easton Police Department responded to 9073 Sage Court in reference to a complaint of vandalism. Upon arriving the officer met with complainant, Aaron Greenwood, who had advised that sometime between September 14th at 8:30 PM and September 15th 8:15 AM an unknown person busted the passenger side window of his 2005 Ford truck. The damage is estimated to be \$600. Nothing was reported stolen from the vehicle.
