1. **Injury Accident:** On October 30, 2015 at approximately 9:22 AM the Easton Police Department responded to an injury accident that occurred on Marlboro Road and the Tred Avon Shopping Center. According to the report a 1993 Buick, which was being driven by 72 year old Brenda Mitchell of Trappe, was traveling east on Marlboro Road. A 2008 Jeep, which was being driven by 61 year old Kimberly Corkran of Trappe, was making left onto Marlboro Road from the Tred Avon Shopping Center. Corkran failed to yield to Mitchell which caused the collision. Debra Greene, 59 year old from St. Michaels, was a passenger in Mitchell's vehicle. Greene was listed as being injured and transported to the Easton Hospital for observations. Corkran was found to be at fault in the accident.
2. **Injury Accident:** On October 30, 2015 at approximately 2:15 PM the Easton Police Department responded to an injury accident that occurred on Dover Road near Park Street. According to the report a 1987 Honda motorcycle, which was being operated by 80 year old Robert Turkington of Trappe, was traveling East on Dover Road when he lost control of his bike. Turkington was transported to Easton Hospital for observations. Investigation into the collision is continuing.

3. **DUI:** On October 31, 2015 at approximately 6:58 PM the Easton Police arrested 31 year old Russell Alexcie Poisson of Easton. According to the report an Easton officer observed Poisson driving in the area of Kohls shopping center with expired registration on his Hyundai Elantra. Poisson was stopped. An investigation ensued and subsequently Poisson was arrested. Poisson was charged with driving vehicle while under the influence of alcohol; driving under the influence of alcohol per se; driving while impaired by alcohol; driving impaired by alcohol; and negligent driving. Poisson was released upon his signature.

4. **DUI:** On November 1, 2015 at approximately 1:25 AM the Easton Police arrested 41 year old Brian Andrew Wood of Easton. According to the report an Easton officer observed Wood operating a 2005 Chrysler on North Street. Wood was observed failing to stop at the stop sign on N. Hanson Street, turning onto Hanson Street and parking on the wrong side of the street at which time the officer stopped Wood. An investigation ensued and Wood was subsequently arrested and charged with the following: driver failure to stop at a stop line; driving vehicle while under the influence of alcohol; driving while impaired by alcohol; and negligent driving. Wood was released upon his signature.
