1. **Bench Warrant Service:** On November 15, 2015 the Easton Police served a warrant on 21 year old Troy Jalen Holmes of Easton Maryland. Holmes was required to appear in Worcester County District Court on October 27, 2015 to answer for the charges of driving on a suspended license and driving without a license. Holmes failed to appear for this court date and a warrant was issued for his arrest. Holmes was seen by a Talbot County District Court Commissioner and was released on his own recognizance.
2. **Arrest:** On November 13, 2015 the Easton Police Department arrested 21 year old Jahad Eric Mills of Trappe during a traffic stop. A vehicle that Mills was traveling in was stopped for an equipment violation. The officer recognized Mills and knew of a warrant that had been issued against him. The warrant accuses Mills of entering into the WaWa, 8118 Ocean Gateway Easton, on August 10, 2015 and stole merchandise valued less than \$100. Mills is charged with one count of theft under \$100 and one count of conspiracy to commit a theft under \$100. Mills was released on his own personal recognizance.

3. **Arrest:** On November 14, 2015 at approximately 8:50 PM the Easton Police responded to 613 Goldsborough Street in reference to an unwanted person. Upon arrival officers they discovered 53 year old Marvel Silvano Valdez-Morales of Easton in a physical confrontation with the owner of the residence, Jonathan Aguilar. Approximately an hour earlier Easton Police was at the residence at which time Morales was escorted off of the property and ordered not to return. Morales was placed under arrest and charged with one count of assault 2nd degree; failure to obey a lawful order; and trespassing. Morales was released on his own recognizance by a Talbot County Court Commissioner.
