The Council of the Town of Easton will hold a public hearing on Monday, March 17, 2014 at 7:30 P.M. in the Council Meeting Room, 14 South Harrison Street. The purpose of this hearing is to discuss the request of Talbot County, Maryland for a license agreement to allow Talbot County to cut down and crown trees located on property owned by the Town of Easton, which is Parcel 138 on Tax Map 25 and is more commonly known as Mistletoe Hall Farm.

The public is hereby invited to comment on this request. Such comments may be either submitted in writing at any time prior to the Hearing, or made in person at the Hearing. Copies of the license agreement and corresponding ordinance, as well as the Forest Conservation Plan and Forest Stand Delineation, are available for public inspection during normal business hours.
